#### Participant Code of Conduct

- Be courteous in your communication with players, teachers, team officials, game officials and parents from other schools, at all times
- Encourage honest effort, skilled performance and team loyalty
- Make any new parents feel welcome on all occasions
- Do not interfere with the conduct of any games
- Do not approach game referees or officials
- Ensure any complaints or issues are dealt with at the end of the event in a professional manner
