We will be reading Running Wild and using some of the themes as a basis for writing a formal letter and an adventure. We will be reading poetry containing imagery; investigating figurative language and features such as personification and alliteration.



Science

We will revise the names and functions of major organs of the body. We will learn about the heart and how it pumps blood around the body by finding out about the 'journey' of a blood cell.

Physical Education

We will develop and improve our throwing, catching, running and jumping to improve our Personal Best. We will work on skills needed for playing badminton.

Music
