During the time that Oak Class are self-isolating, I will be setting work on Teams on a daily basis. I am aware that not everybody is able to do this and so I am providing some ideas for home learning using the resources we have already sent home.

Power Maths. Anything up to p 40 has already been covered in class, so children should be able to do this. If you need any help, there are videos available here:

I have attached a division worksheet that your child should be able to complete along with a multiplication square if (s)he needs support with multiplication tables.

Your child has brought home 3 English Books: Handwriting, Reading and Comprehension. By the end of this week, we will have completed the following:

Handwriting p 2-4

Reading: The Story of the Amulet (p 22-23) and completed Question Sets 1 and 2. Answers can be checked in the back of the book.

Purple Mash: I have set some activities for the children to complete.

TTRockstars: practice will really help accuracy and speed of recall.
