- Preparing our children for life in Modern Britain, encouraging them to live alongside others in harmony






Worship

Some of our Year 5/6 pupils took part in the Football Festival at Spirit of Sport, where they played some friendly 7-a-side games.




Forest School


Bonkers for Conkers


