## Music

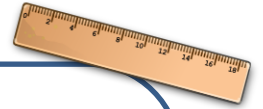
This half term we will be continuing our music learning songs through the topic of Hey You and learning the songs for our Nativity performance!

## Phonics/Spelling

## Maths

We will be learning mathematics using a variety of concrete approaches and hands on experience. We will be continuing to explore Place Value and using this knowledge to develop our skills in Addition and Subtraction. We will recognise coins and their values and using this knowledge to solve problems based on money. We will also be learning about 2-D and 3-D shapes.



## Place and Time
